

Dr. Rajesh Komath, Assistant Professor of Social Sciences, School of Social Sciences, Mahatma Gandhi University teaches courses such as political economy and cultural dynamics, and economics of discrimination to the post-graduate students of economics, sociology and history. He did his post-graduation in Development Economics at University of Calicut and MPhil (Master of Philosophy) in Applied Economics at Centre for Development Studies, Thiruvananthapuram affiliated to the Jawaharlal Nehru University, New Delhi. His MPhil dissertation was on '*Social and Economic Mobility of a Traditional Social Group: Case Study of Theyyam Performing Community of North Kerala*' and had completed his PhD in Interdisciplinary Social Sciences in the area of Political Economy and completed his doctoral work titled '*Political Economy of the Theyyam: A Study of Time-Space Homology*'.

Being a social scientist and a member of the Dalit community in India, he has researched on marginalisation process of development initiatives, and published papers and monographs detailing the socioeconomic implications of economic change in the past and the contemporary. He has independently conducted many research projects and the undergoing one is titled as '*Self-Help Groups in Kerala: A Study in Economic Sociology*' funded by the University Grants Commission, New Delhi. He has numerous writings in his mother tongue-Malayalam including books and articles.

His recent publications are '*Dalit as Margin Body: Re-reading Untouchability and Exclusionary Practices*' (2019) '*Green Economics: Need of the Contemporary World*' (2015), '*Ambedkar Will Teach the Nation from His Statues* (2017) in Economic and Political Weekly (EPW), and '*The Subversion of Institutions and Creation of a Cultural Discourse*' (2017) in EPW. He is a research supervisor of MPhil and Doctoral thesis in the discipline of Economics, Sociology and other interdisciplinary areas such as social exclusion, discrimination and public health.
