DCDC/IQAC/2007 dated 21.8.2007 were deliberated upon by all members of the permanent faculty of SSS through successive meetings and unanimously approved when they meting Council on 7th November 2007.

The guidelines shall be in force from the above mentioned date, and shall continued to be operative till the Faculty Council, acting by consensus or by majority, decides to effect changes in any or all of these, on its own or two conform to any revision in regulations by the University.
